The NSW Chess Association invites entries for the 2023 NSW Rapid hosted by Ryde Eastwood

**Venue:** Ryde-Eastwood Leagues Club  
117 Ryedale Road  
West Ryde, NSW  
(Easy walk from West Ryde train station)  
*Licensed club rules apply*

**When:** Sunday 9th July

**Schedule:** 10:15-10:30am Registration  
11am Round 1

**Format:** 7 round Swiss

**Prizes:** 1<sup>st</sup> \$300 2<sup>nd</sup> \$250 3<sup>rd</sup> \$200  
U2000-1800, U1800-1600, U1600-1400 and U1400  
\$150 in each division

**Time Control:** 15 minutes each per game plus 10 seconds per move.

#### Entry fees:

**If registered by 7 July:** \$25 including all titled players  
**If registered on 8 July:** \$35 including all titled players  
**If registered on 9 July:** \$50 including all titled players

- The event will be ACF & FIDE rated. All foreign players must have a FIDE Identification number.
- **All players under 18 years of age must have a parent or guardian on the premises at all times.**
- **Entry for players under 18 years of age is restricted to those who have an ACF Quick rating of at least 1100 (if unrated then ACF standard of at least 1100) or a FIDE Rapid rating of at least 1400 (if unrated then FIDE standard of at least 1400).**
- You need to register **and pay** by 7 July to be eligible for the early entry fee.
- **Entries on the day of the tournament** will be included in the round 1 draw at the arbiter's discretion.  
**Absolutely no entries will be accepted after 10:30am.**
- Players are eligible for one prize only. Rating prizes are based on ACF ratings. Unrated players are not eligible for rating-restricted prizes.
- **Forfeit times:** Any player who arrives at the chessboard after their time has elapsed shall lose the game unless the arbiter decides otherwise.
- All NSW resident players must be full members for 2023 of (or join) the NSWCA or the NSWJCL.
- By entering the event, players acknowledge that the decision of the organiser (NSWCA) is final.

- All prizes not redeemed within 3 months will be treated as donations to the next Olympiad.

**Note:** All foreign players must have a FIDE Identification number.

Australian Citizens & Permanent residents without FIDE ID numbers will need to provide DOB prior to the start of the event or their entry will not be accepted.

Foreign players without a FIDE ID number will not be accepted. They will need to obtain a FIDE ID number from their National Federation and advise that number prior to their entry being accepted.
