If registered by 28 September: Adult: \$62.00 Junior [U18]: \$56.00 Pensioner: \$52.00

If registered on 29 September: Adult: \$80.00 Junior [U18]: \$72.00 Pensioner: \$68.00

If registered on 30 September: Adult: \$100.00 Junior [U18]: \$92.00 Pensioner: \$88.00

- The tournament will be ACF rated.
- **Entry for players under 18 years of age is restricted to those who have an ACF standard rating of at least 1100 or a FIDE standard rating of at least 1400.**
- You need to register **and pay** by 28 September to be eligible for the early entry fee.
- **Entries on the day of the tournament** will be included in the round 1 draw at the arbiter's discretion. **Absolutely no entries will be accepted after 10:30am.**
- **Full-time students under 25** can enter at the junior rate. Student ID card must be produced on the day of the tournament otherwise the applicable adult entry fee will be charged.
- **For Pensioner discount**, Pensioner Concession Card or Commonwealth Seniors Health Card must be produced on the day of the tournament otherwise the applicable adult entry fee will be charged.
- Exemption from entry fees: FIDE titleholders – GM, IM, WGM, WIM. Entry must be received **by the early entry cut off date** of 28 September or full entry fees must be paid.
- Players are eligible for 1 prize only. Rating prizes are based on ACF ratings. Unrated players are not eligible for rating restricted prizes.
- **Forfeit times:** Any player who arrives at the chessboard more than **30 minutes** after the start of the session shall lose the game unless the arbiter decides otherwise.
- All NSW resident players must be full members of (or join) the NSWCA or the NSWJCL.
- By entering the event players acknowledge that the decision of the organiser (NSWCA) is final.

- Players may request up to two half point byes prior to the start of the round before the bye is needed. Half point byes are not available in the last two rounds.
