

Chatswood Checkmate Allegro

Willoughby Council and The NSW Chess Association invite entries for the Chatswood Checkmate Allegro tournament.

Venue: The Concourse
409 Victoria Avenue,
Chatswood.

The tournament will take place in the foyer of the Concourse.

When: Sunday 19th May

Schedule: 10:30am Round 1

Format: 7 round Swiss

Prizes: 1st \$300 2nd \$250 3rd \$200
U2000-1800, U1800-1600, U1600-1400 and U1400
\$150 in each division

Time Control: 10 minutes each per game plus 5 seconds per move.

Entry fees:

If registered by 17 May: \$25 including all titled players

If registered on 18 May: \$35 including all titled players

- The event will be ACF & FIDE rated. All foreign players must have a FIDE Identification number.
- You need to register **and pay** by 17 May to be eligible for the early entry fee. **No entries will be accepted on the day**
- Players are eligible for one prize only. Rating prizes are based on ACF ratings. Unrated players are not eligible for rating-restricted prizes.
- **Forfeit times:** Any player who arrives at the chessboard after their time has elapsed shall lose the game unless the arbiter decides otherwise.
- All NSW resident players must be full members for 2024 of (or join) the NSWCA or the NSWJCL.
- By entering the event, players acknowledge that the decision of the organiser (NSWCA) is final.

- All prizes not redeemed within 3 months will be treated as donations to the next Olympiad.
- Chatswood is a major transport hub with buses and trains nearby. There is parking available underneath the Concourse at \$8 for the day.

Note: All foreign players must have a FIDE Identification number.

Australian Citizens & Permanent residents without FIDE ID numbers will need to provide DOB prior to the start of the event or their entry will not be accepted.

Foreign players without a FIDE ID number will not be accepted. They will need to obtain a FIDE ID number from their National Federation and advise that number prior to their entry being accepted.
