**Format:** 9 round Swiss

**Prizes:** 1st \$300 2nd \$250 3rd \$200

U2000-1800, U1800-1600, U1600-1400 and U1400

\$150 in each division

**Time Control:** 3 minutes plus 2 seconds per move

**Entry fees:** 

If registered by 1 March: \$35 including all titled players
If registered on 2 March: \$50 including all titled players

- The event will be ACF & FIDE rated. All foreign players must have a FIDE Identification number.
- All players under 13 years of age must have a parent or guardian on the premises at all times.
- You need to register **and pay** by 1 March to be eligible for the early entry fee.
- Absolutely no entries will be accepted on the day.
- Players are eligible for one prize only. Rating prizes are based on ACF ratings. Unrated players are not eligible for rating-restricted prizes.
- **Forfeit times:** Any player who arrives at the chessboard after their time has elapsed shall lose the game unless the arbiter decides otherwise.
- All NSW resident players must be full members for 2024 of (or join) the NSWCA or the NSWJCL.
- To be eligible to win the title of City of Sydney Blitz Champion the player must live within the County of Cumberland
- By entering the event, players acknowledge that the decision of the organiser (NSWCA) is final.

- All prizes not redeemed within 3 months will be treated as donations to the next Olympiad.

**Note:** All foreign players must have a FIDE Identification number.

Australian Citizens & Permanent residents without FIDE ID numbers will need to provide DOB prior to the start of the event or their entry will not be accepted.

Foreign players without a FIDE ID number will not be accepted. They will need to obtain a FIDE ID number from their National Federation and advise that number prior to their entry being accepted.
